MEOROT ADAPTS TO CONTINUE MISSION

Navigating the uncertainties surrounding COVID necessitated a different approach during the 2020-21 academic year. Meorot adapted and the Meorot Board decided to suspend inperson classes and to focus instead on the following three services: 1) Tutoring matching service -- where Meorot matches a student or a small cohort of students with an appropriate teacher and modality (online or in-person) 2) complimentary parent-child zoom workshop teaching about upcoming chagim and 3) Parent workshops focusing on practical parenting topics. Meorot also opened up the workshops to all elementary aged children in the community.

The formula of Meorot Parent-Child Zoom workshops was to provide a fun enriching activity while learning about an upcoming Chag. The series kicked off with a Succot workshop featuring a creative project led by Corrine Franco, Meorot Board Member, where she demonstrated how we can creatively use dried fruit to make beautiful centerpieces

for our Sukkahs. The event also featured an inspiring d'var torah from Rabbi Eli Slomnicki, principal of HANC High School. The Chanukah workshop was led by Meorot Educator Morah Marie Rosenthal who did a wonderful job providing a glimpse of the Meorot educational approach while reviewing the key aspects of Chanukah. Jonathan Zar of DJZJ then got the students on their feet while dancing to Chanukah songs and displaying their take home Chanukah crafts creations organized by Corinne Franco. Rabbi Nir & Sigal Shalom, of the Babylonian Jewish Center, led a Tu B'Shvat workshop where they guided participants through a Seder Brachot where students took turns reciting the five "Maga Esh" brachot. Musician Noam Segal then led participants in song and dance related to Tu B'Shvat, Chodesh Adar was welcomed by Morah Marie who again gave families a taste of Meorot by presenting the key concepts of Purim in a very animated manner with lots of reinforcements. Subsequently Corinne Franco led a wonderful crafts segment
